

Franzman Family Nursing Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This scholarship is offered by Seth and Barbara Franzman in appreciation for nurses and the nursing profession by assisting with the education expenses of deserving students in the Associate of Applied Science Nursing program at Otero Junior College.
2. Scholarship amount is \$1,500 per year (\$750.00 per semester) to be used for tuition and fees. Recipient must be a citizen of the United States, graduate from an accredited high school with a 2.5 grade point average or higher. Although high academic achievement is important, the recipient's motivation, dedication, potential for academic success and financial need will be used as determining factors as well. The scholarship may be rescinded if the recipient's grade point average falls below 2.5 or the recipient exhibits behavior that is not consistent with the rules of Otero Junior College. Funding for the scholarship will be the interest earned from funds that have been invested. Should the interest be less than \$1,500, the scholarship will be adjusted to the interest yield amount.
3. The recipient will be chosen by the Otero Junior College Scholarship Committee on the basis outlined above, letters of recommendation as well as the needs, circumstances, and the abilities of the candidate.
4. Priority will be given to a graduate of either Crowley County or Cheraw High School who is pursuing a Registered Nurse (RN) designation and has been admitted to the Associate of Applied Science Nursing program at Otero Junior College. In addition to Crowley County or Cheraw High School graduates, preference will be given to graduates of accredited high schools from the following counties: Baca, Bent, Kiowa, Otero, and Prowers.
5. Scholarship will be awarded for the 2012-2013 academic year.
