GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Kane Family Scholars scholarship is a program designed to assist Otero Junior College students in their efforts to pursue a Bachelor's degree at the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs. The program will enable a student to graduate from Otero Junior College and transfer to UCCS with financial assistance towards books, tuition, and fees.

2. Recipients will receive the funds based on academic merit and the funds shall only be used in the payment of tuition, books, and mandatory fees.

3. The recipients will be chosen by the Otero Junior College Foundation Scholarship Committee on the basis outlined below:

- Students must be accepted for joint admissions into the UCCS University Connection program through Otero Junior College.
- Freshman students must have completed high school with a GPA of at least 3.25
- Returning students must have earned a minimum of 12 credit hours of college level courses with a GPA of at least 3.25
- Recipients must maintain at least a 3.0 GPA for continued funding.
