5. Consideration will be given to applicants who plan to attend Otero Junior College or any other Colorado college or university.
6. An essay which illustrates the applicant's leadership and personal attributes that would honor Rotary's Four-Way Test for its membership n how they conduct their lives:
 - a. Is it the truth?
 - b. Is it fair to all concerned?
 - c. Will it build goodwill and better friendships?
 - d. Will it be beneficial to all concerned?
7. Two letters of recommendation.
