

CECIL COLLEY / JOHN GWYN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. First priority will be given to students whose area of study is engineering or physical science with the intent of meeting the requirements for an Associate of Science degree at Otero Junior College. Students that are in another area are still encouraged to apply. Scholarships will be awarded to a freshman and sophomore who are enrolled full time.
2. The recipient receives \$2,500 (\$1,250 per semester) for the first year. The scholarship is continued for a second year for \$2,500 (\$1,250 per semester) if the recipient remains in the same area of study and maintains at least a 3.0 G.P.A.
3. The recipient is chosen by the Otero Junior College Scholarship Committee on the basis of the student's major area, past G.P.A., letters of reference from high school teachers, and the likelihood of success as demonstrated on the ACT and similar tests. (Financial need is not a requirement.)
