2012-2013

PURPOSE

This scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors who plan to attend OJC full-time for the 2012-2013 academic year and will be majoring in an area of the arts. This scholarship will pay \$1,000 of tuition and \$150.00 towards college related expenses per semester. If a recipient has already received a tuition scholarship from OJC, they will not be eligible for the tuition portion of this scholarship.

To be eligible for the scholarship the candidate must:

- Be a United States Citizen and a resident of Colorado.
- Attend Otero Junior College on a full-time basis.
- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative G.P.A. at OJC.
- Participate in activities associated with the arts while at OJC.
- Graduate from High School with a 3.0 cumulative GPA or above.
- Must be majoring an area of the arts (graphic, theatre, dance, history, political science, speech, literature, or foreign language).

APPLICATION PROCESS

Application forms are available at Otero Junior College Student Services Center, or from your high school counselor.

A complete application will consist of the following information:

1. Completed application form.
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation from high school instructors, counselors, or administrators (one must be from an instructor in your area of interest).
3. Letter from applicant identifying career goals and why they feel they would be a good recipient for this scholarship.
4. Official copy of high school transcript.
5. Portfolio, video, or some demonstration of competence in area of interest.
